## Summary of Experience

Ivan Harbour joined Rogers Stirk Harbour + Partners in 1985 when it was Richard Rogers Partnership and was made a Senior Director in 1993. The practice change (in 2007) reflects Ivan's design contribution to the practice. Ivan is currently Design Director of a number of prestigious international architecture and masterplanning projects including the Parc1 - Yeouido mixed-use scheme in Seoul, South Korea, as well as projects in the USA and Europe. Ivan is integrally involved in these projects from concept design stage through to the built scheme.

Landmark buildings for which Ivan has led the design include the National Assembly for Wales, Terminal 4 Barajas Airport, Madrid (winner of the 2006 Stirling Prize), Mossbourne Community Academy, the Law Courts in Antwerp and Bordeaux and the European Court of Human Rights in Strasbourg. More recently, Ivan has been Project Director for the first Maggie's Cancer Centre in London and 300 New Jersey Avenue, an office building in Washington DC (due for completion in Summer 2009).

Ivan has contributed to the design of a number of major masterplanning projects. He was Director in Charge of the proposed redevelopment of the South Bank Centre in London, ParcBIT in Mallorca, and the Antwerp New South masterplan.
