## Summary of Experience

Ivan began his career on Lloyd's of London and subsequently led the design of the European Court of Human Rights and Bordeaux Law Courts. He was made a Director in 1993, a Senior Director in 1998 and a Named Partner in 2011. In 2007 the name of the practice was changed from Richard Rogers Partnership in recognition of Ivan and Graham Stirk's contribution. Together with Richard, they are evolving the design-led practice for the future.

Ivan has considerable experience of directing complex projects, both large and small, and of many different types. Each is a unique response born out of a pursuit of the best and a thorough questioning of design proposals based on a language of: context, public realm, legibility, flexibility, sustainability and teamwork.

Two of Ivan's projects - Maggie's Centre, London (2009) and Terminal 4 Barajas Airport Madrid (2006) have won the Stirling Prize - the most prestigious architectural award in the UK. Projects designed and led by Ivan include: the Barangaroo masterplan and International Towers, Sydney, Australia; 300 New Jersey Avenue offices in Washington DC, USA; the National Assembly for Wales in Cardiff, Wales; Law Courts in Antwerp; Minami Yamashiro School, Kyoto, Japan; plus a mixed-use project in Scandicci, Italy consisting of a tram station, a cultural centre, an office building and a residential block. Significantly, these projects have all been recognised by either national, European or international awards.

Ivan is currently leading the design on the Melbourne Metro Rail project. Other live projects include Taoyuan T3 airport; the LSE in London; a new mixed-used piece of city in Monte Carlo which includes a commercial gallery space; the Spy Museum in Washington and the masterplan and two buildings within The International Quarter in Stratford, London.

Ivan has also been instrumental in developing modular housing for temporary housing schemes at Y-Cube, Mitcham and PLACE/Ladywell in Lewisham, London, UK.
