## Summary of Experience

Lennart Grut is the Partner principally in charge of managing the practice's key international projects. He has particular expertise in the planning and design of major airport projects and has been director in charge of Terminal 5, Heathrow Airport, London and Terminal 4, Barajas Airport, Madrid, which won the Stirling Prize in 2006. Current airport projects include major extensions to in Taipei, Geneva and Lyon airports.

He has been involved in setting up the practice's new work in Mexico, Lebanon, China and South America. Projects include the new Headquarters for BBVA in Mexico City and Atrio, two new mixed-use towers in Bogota that aim to be a catalyst for regenerating the old CBD Centro Internacional area.

There are also projects in Beijing, Shanghai, and Chongqing in China as well as Taipei and Singapore. Lennart also helps RSHP to maintain a continued presence in Europe; in particular, Italy and France where we currently have projects in Naples, Scandicci, Paris and Lyon.
